**RetailROI helps to meet the pressing needs of those seeking to rebuild South Sudan**

**Fulaa Lifeline International** is a Christian ministry working among the suffering people of South Sudan, which partners with local churches to bring the compassion of Jesus Christ to people in great need.

In 2005 when Pastor Juma John resettled with his church into the town of Nimule from a refugee camp in Uganda, homeless children came to him looking for help. These helpless children were orphaned by war & disease; some had been abandoned or abused. The newly transplanted church took them in, initially providing a weekend feeding program. Eventually, a residential program grew out of this compassionate care. From the beginning, Fulaa Lifeline International worked alongside the church to help in this effort.

**Cornerstone Children's Home** is the result of that church-based effort to care for the needy children of Nimule. Today more than 60 children are housed, fed and nurtured in a loving Christian environment.



A new building is nearing completion located on the same compound as the church, which will provide a safe and healthy place for the children to live. In addition, a primary school program has begun for



the children with the goal to expand the educational work of the Children's Home into vocational training and micro-economic opportunities.

Through its partnership with Fulaa Lifeline International, RetailROI is involved in front-line and immediate help in caring for kids in one of the neediest parts of the world.
